OVERVIEW:

- Strong to severe storms are possible across interior southern New England Saturday afternoon and evening.
- Primary hazards include damaging winds, hail, and a low probability of a tornado.
- Greatest risk is in western/central MA and western CT, with storms expected to weaken as they move into RI and eastern MA Saturday night.

HAZARDS & IMPACTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Winds strong enough to down trees and power lines, with potential structural damage.▪ Large hail possible.▪ A low probability of a tornado.
NWS ALERTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ None at this time.
FORECAST CHALLENGES	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Timing of the front; it has slowed down, limiting the threat for RI and eastern MA.
POST-EVENT OUTLOOK	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Rain may continue Sunday morning, especially for RI and southeast MA but with only a low risk of thunder.
