

# Strong Storms Possible Saturday PM



## OVERVIEW:

- Strong to severe storms are possible across interior southern New England Saturday afternoon and evening.
- Primary hazards include damaging winds, hail, and a low probability of a tornado.
- Greatest risk is in western/central MA and western CT, with storms expected to weaken as they move into RI and eastern MA Saturday night.

<b>TIMING</b>	▪ 2 - 10 PM Saturday	
<b>HAZARDS &amp; IMPACTS</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ Winds strong enough to down trees and power lines, with potential structural damage.</li><li>▪ Large hail possible.</li><li>▪ A low probability of a tornado.</li></ul>	
<b>NWS ALERTS</b>	▪ None at this time.	
<b>FORECAST CHALLENGES</b>	▪ Timing of the front; it has slowed down, limiting the threat for RI and eastern MA.
