



OVERVIEW:

- Widespread showers and embedded t-storms with locally heavy rainfall into this evening.
- 1 to 2 inches of rain, but localized amounts up to 3 inches may produce areas of urban and poor drainage street flooding.
- Low risk for an isolated severe storm across western CT/MA. Primary hazards include damaging winds and even a tornado.

TIMING	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Heavy rainfall this morning into this evening. ▪ Best chance of severe storms this afternoon.
HAZARDS & IMPACTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Localized street flooding. ▪ Low risk of a tornado or damaging wind gusts, mainly across western CT and western MA .
NWS ALERTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ None at this time.
FORECAST CHALLENGES	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Where the axis of heaviest rainfall sets up is uncertain. ▪ Will there be enough instability to realize the severe weather risk.
POST-EVENT OUTLOOK	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Improving conditions Friday. Warm and humid with increasing sunshine
