



OVERVIEW:

- Widespread showers and embedded t-storms with locally heavy rainfall into this evening.
- 1 to 2 inches of rain, but localized amounts up to 3 inches may produce areas of urban and poor drainage street flooding.
- Low risk for an isolated severe storm across western CT/MA. Primary hazards include damaging winds and a even a tornado.

TIMING	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ Heavy rainfall this morning into this evening.</li><li>▪ Best chance of severe storms this afternoon.</li></ul>
HAZARDS & IMPACTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ Localized street flooding.</li><li>▪ Low risk of a tornado or damaging wind gusts, mainly across western CT and western MA .</li></ul>
NWS ALERTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ None at this time.</li></ul>
FORECAST CHALLENGES	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ Where the axis of heaviest rainfall sets up is uncertain.</li><li>▪ Will there be enough instability to realize the severe weather risk.</li></ul>
POST-EVENT OUTLOOK	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ Improving conditions Friday. Warm and humid with increasing sunshine</li></ul>
