## For Southern New England

### Key Messages


- A storm moving up the coast will bring potential for heavy rain, strong winds, and minor coastal flooding.
- **Timing:** Late today into Monday night. Winds peaking tonight and Monday morning.
- **Hazards/Impacts:** Downed branches/trees, power lines, and possible power outages. The strongest winds are expected on Cape Cod and the islands. Hazardous wind and sea conditions on the MA/RI coastal waters.
- Improving conditions mid week.



Late Sunday through Monday




**8 PM Today - 8 PM Mon**



- 40-50 KT possible




- Wind and wave conditions will be hazardous for small craft.



**East (greater risk) and South (lesser risk) Facing Beaches**




- **Up to a one foot of inundation above ground level possible in low lying areas**
- **Beach Erosion & Minor Coastal Inundation Possible**







- Strongest wind gusts will occur late today into Monday morning
- Wind direction will be primarily from the east
- Given trees remain fully leaved, winds may be strong enough to produce tree damage and power outages, especially along the south coast and islands.












# Nantucket Harbor - Water Level Forecast

- Multiple tide cycles beginning Sunday afternoon through Monday evening are expected to result in minor flooding, possible for the Tuesday afternoon high tide.
- Localized moderate impact coastal flooding may develop if winds end up being stronger than currently forecast and/or overall storm surge is higher.
- Areas of minor to possibly moderate beach erosion expected, especially east facing beaches.




- Sunday afternoon, Sunday evening and Monday afternoon high all have potential for minor flooding.


