

Accumulating Snow Possible Tue



OVERVIEW:

- Low pressure from the mid-Atlantic on Tuesday may bring accumulating snow or snow-to-rain to Southern New England.
- Best chance for accumulating snows in interior Southern New England (north and west of I-95) and the higher terrain.

| TIMING | ▪ Tuesday and Tuesday night. | |
| HAZARDS & IMPACTS | <ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Slippery untreated roads/sidewalks from accumulation of wet snow.▪ Isolated minor tree damage from snow loading in interior Southern New England (if accumulations are large enough). | |
| NWS ALERTS | ▪ None at this time. | |
| FORECAST CHALLENGES | <ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Uncertain storm track which will influence precip types & accumulations.▪ Eastern MA & RI may struggle to see accumulating snow given warm water temperatures & onshore flow.▪ Time of day may affect accumulations on roads vs grass. | |
| POST-EVENT OUTLOOK | <ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Blustery Wed but drying out.▪ Below normal temps for late-week. |  |
