

# Accumulating Snow Possible Tue

## OVERVIEW:

- Low pressure from the mid-Atlantic on Tuesday may bring accumulating snow or snow-to-rain to Southern New England.
- Best chance for accumulating snows in interior Southern New England (north and west of I-95) and the higher terrain.

<b>TIMING</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ Tuesday and Tuesday night.</li></ul>
<b>HAZARDS &amp; IMPACTS</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ Slippery untreated roads/sidewalks from accumulation of wet snow.</li><li>▪ Isolated minor tree damage from snow loading in interior Southern New England (if accumulations are large enough).</li></ul>
<b>NWS ALERTS</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ None at this time.</li></ul>
<b>FORECAST CHALLENGES</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ Uncertain storm track which will influence precip types &amp; accumulations.</li><li>▪ Eastern MA &amp; RI may struggle to see accumulating snow given warm water temperatures &amp; onshore flow.</li><li>▪ Time of day may affect accumulations on roads vs grass.</li></ul>
<b>POST-EVENT OUTLOOK</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ Blustery Wed but drying out.</li><li>▪ Below normal temps for late-week.</li></ul>
<b>NEXT BRIEFING</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ Saturday Afternoon (sooner if needed).</li></ul>
