OVERVIEW:

- Accumulating snow likely across interior southern New England, north and west of I-95, Tuesday into Tuesday night.
 - Best chance for significant accumulation (greater than 6 inches) is over the higher terrain across interior MA.

| FORECAST CHALLENGES | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> A further south track could bring more snow accumulation into eastern MA and RI. |
| FORECAST CHALLENGES | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> A further north track will shift heavier accumulations to the north. |
| POST-EVENT OUTLOOK | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Blustery Wed but drying out. Blustery and bitter cold Thursday night and Friday. |
| NEXT BRIEFING | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Monday Afternoon (sooner if needed). |
