


OVERVIEW:

- Accumulating snow with the chance for significant accumulation (greater than 6 inches) over the higher terrain across interior MA.
- Overall confidence in the location and magnitude of the heaviest snow has increased.

<b>TIMING</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ Snow begins in the higher terrain 7–10 AM</li><li>▪ Rain spreads into the coastal plain after 10 AM</li><li>▪ Ending west to east 8 PM – midnight</li></ul>
<b>HAZARDS &amp; IMPACTS</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ Hazardous travel conditions.</li><li>▪ Power outages possible from accumulation of wet snow.</li></ul>
<b>NWS ALERTS</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ Winter Storm Warning for much of MA west of I-95.</li><li>▪ Winter Weather Advisories for much of MA except for the Boston Metro and areas SE of I-95.</li></ul>
<b>FORECAST CHALLENGES</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ Amount of snowfall on the backside of the system as temperatures fall below freezing Tuesday night.</li><li>▪ Still some uncertainty w/ the northward extent of warmer air which could reduce totals. Biggest risk at lower elevations.</li></ul>
<b>POST-EVENT OUTLOOK</b>	<div><div><ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ Blustery and below average temperatures Wed to Fri.</li><li>▪ Thu night wind chills fall to either side of zero.</li></ul></div><div></div></div>
