



# Strong Wind Gusts Today Into Fri AM

## OVERVIEW:

- Westerly wind gusts of 35 to 50 mph today into Friday morning.
- Wind Chills tonight will drop to between 0 and 10 above and briefly sub-zero in the high terrain.

<b>TIMING</b>	▪ Westerly wind gusts of 35 to 50 mph develop this morning and continue into Friday morning. Wind chills drop to between 5 below and 10 above zero tonight.	
<b>HAZARDS &amp; IMPACTS</b>	▪ A few downed branches, power lines, and weakened trees.	
<b>NWS ALERTS</b>	▪ Wind Advisory for all of southern New England.	
<b>FORECAST CHALLENGES</b>	▪ High confidence in westerly wind gusts between 35 and 50 mph into Friday morning. Low risk for a few brief gusts up to 55 mph.	
<b>POST-EVENT OUTLOOK</b>	▪ Cold temperatures and westerly wind gusts of 25 to 35 mph with a few gusts up to 40 mph will persist Friday afternoon.
