

- Accumulating Snow possible Sat night into Sun.
- 1-2" south of I-90 with localized 3-4" possible towards the south coast.
- A dusting to 1" of snow north of I-90.
- These snowfall amounts are preliminary and may increase or decrease.

TIMING	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Main window for accumulating snow is later Sat night into Sun morning. Bulk of accumulating snow should end by Sun afternoon...except towards the Cape and Islands where it may linger into Sun afternoon and evening.
HAZARDS & IMPACTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Untreated roads will likely become snow covered and slippery late Saturday night into Sunday morning. Most likely snow accumulations currently are 1-2" south of I-90 with localized 3-4" possible near the south coast.
NWS ALERTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> No NWS alerts in effect at this time.
FORECAST CHALLENGES	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The northern extent of the snow shield, which will impact accumulations. A trend further north would bring the risk for 1-2" north of I-90 with 3-5" south. A trend further south than expected would bring little if any snowfall north of I-90 and just a coating to 1" south of I-90.
POST-EVENT OUTLOOK	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Dry, but very cold weather Sunday night except for lingering snow showers across the Cape and Nantucket. Lows by early Mon am will be in the high single digits and teens. Wind Chills -5 to 10.
