WEATHER FORECAST OFFICE

OVERVIEW:

- Accumulating Snow late tonight into Sunday morning.
- 1-3" south of I-90 with up to 4" possible near the south coast.
- A dusting to 1" of snow north of I-90.
- Winter Weather Advisory for south coast including Cape & Islands.

TIMING	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Snow overspreads the region between 9 pm tonight and 3 am Sunday.▪ Accumulating snow should end by Sunday afternoon, but ocean effect snow showers will linger into Sun night for the Cape and Islands.
HAZARDS & IMPACTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Untreated roads will likely become snow covered and overnight into Sunday morning.
NWS ALERTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Winter Weather Advisory for the south coast, Cape and Islands.
FORECAST CHALLENGES	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ A shift north or south of the main axis of accumulating snow.▪ Lower probability outcomes...A shift north would bring 1-2" snow to the NH border with 3-6" across RI/SE MA. A shift south would confine the 1-2" amounts to near the south coast with less amounts northward.
POST-EVENT OUTLOOK	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Dry, but very cold Sunday night except for lingering snow showers across the Cape and Nantucket.▪ Lows by early Mon am will be in the high single digits and teens. Wind Chills -5 to 5.
