OVERVIEW:

- Strong to damaging wind gusts from 55 to 60 mph possible Friday on the Cape and Islands.
- Wind gusts from 40 to 50 mph possible across the rest of southern New England Friday and Friday evening, isolated 60 mph gusts possible over high terrain/Berkshires

TIMING	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Strongest wind gusts Friday morning, lingering into the early afternoon over the Cape and Islands.▪ Advisory level winds possible through late Friday evening
HAZARDS & IMPACTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ A few downed branches and power lines▪ Power outages are possible.
NWS ALERTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ High Wind Watch for Cape Cod and Islands.▪ Wind Advisory for rest of southern New England
FORECAST CHALLENGES	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Magnitude of strongest wind gusts on the Cape/Islands.
POST-EVENT OUTLOOK	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Continued windy and turning much colder Friday night with lows dropping into the 20s.▪ 30-40 mph wind gusts continue through Saturday morning for Cape/Islands and High Terrain
