


OVERVIEW:

- Accumulating snow likely Tuesday especially across the interior.
- Preliminary snowfall forecast is for 1-3" with the greatest risk across interior southern New England. Localized 4" amounts possible in the high terrain.

TIMING	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Snow begins within a few hours on either side of daybreak Tuesday.▪ Snow may change to rain near and southeast of I-95 Tuesday afternoon.▪ Bulk of accumulating snow likely over by early Tuesday evening.	
HAZARDS & IMPACTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Untreated roads may be snow covered and slippery on Tuesday especially across interior southern New England.	
NWS ALERTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ None at this time.	
FORECAST CHALLENGES	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Does snow arrive before or after the bulk of the Tuesday morning commute. How far northwest does the change from snow to rain advance Tuesday afternoon.	
POST-EVENT OUTLOOK	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Dry but it will be quite blustery Wed with gusty northwest winds.
