



## OVERVIEW:

- Clipper system brings accumulating snowfall to parts of southern New England Friday night through Saturday morning.
- Greatest confidence in impactful snowfall are across central and western Connecticut and western Massachusetts.
  - Snowfall amounts between 2-4", localized 5"
- Less in the way of snow for Rhode Island and central and eastern Massachusetts.
  - Snowfall amounts between a coating to 2"

TIMING	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ Snow enters from west to east Friday evening, 8pm to midnight. Though areas long the east coast of Massachusetts onset of light snow between midnight and 2am.</li><li>▪ Snow winds down early Saturday morning, ending as light snow showers between 6am and 9am.</li></ul>	
HAZARDS & IMPACTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ Snow accumulation on roadways could lead to slow and slick travel Friday night through Saturday morning.</li></ul>	
NWS ALERTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ Winter Weather Advisory for Hartford County and western Hampshire County between 8pm Friday and 10am Saturday.</li></ul>	
FORECAST CHALLENGES	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ A narrow snowfall gradient, a subtle shift in track will impact snowfall accumulations.</li></ul>	
POST-EVENT OUTLOOK	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ Drier weather for Saturday afternoon and into early Sunday with below normal temperatures.</li><li>▪ Late Sunday into Monday a renewed chance for wintry mixed precipitation.</li></ul>
