


OVERVIEW:

- Clipper system brings accumulating snowfall to southern New England tonight
- Greatest confidence in impactful snowfall are across western MA/CT
  - Snowfall amounts between 6-8+” western MA/CT
  - Snowfall amounts between 3-5” central/southeast MA and eastern CT
- Generally less snow for northeast MA
  - Snowfall amounts between 1-3”

TIMING	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ Snow enters from west to east Friday evening, 7pm to 10pm. Though areas along the east coast of Massachusetts onset of light snow between midnight and 2am.</li><li>▪ Moderate to heavy snow winds down early Saturday morning by 4am, with light snow showers lingering between 5am and 8am.</li></ul>
HAZARDS & IMPACTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ Snow accumulation on roadways could lead to slow and slick travel tonight through Saturday morning.</li></ul>
NWS ALERTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ Winter Storm Warnings for Western Hampden County and Hartford County</li><li>▪ Winter Weather Advisory expanded east to include northern RI/southeast MA</li></ul>
FORECAST CHALLENGES	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ Where the heaviest snow band sets up in SW CT.</li><li>▪ Ocean enhanced snow showers may boost snow totals in SE MA</li></ul>
POST-EVENT OUTLOOK	<div><ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ Drier weather for Saturday afternoon and into early Sunday with below normal temperatures.</li><li>▪ Freezing rain chances increasing for late Sunday into early Monday</li></ul></div> <div></div>
