

# Snowfall Friday PM to Saturday AM

## OVERVIEW:

- Clipper system brings accumulating snowfall to parts of southern New England Friday night into early Saturday morning.
- Greatest confidence in impactful snowfall are across western MA, through all of CT and into southern RI.
  - Snowfall amounts between 2-4", localized 5-6" in CT"
- Less in the way of snow for central into northeast MA
  - Snowfall amounts between a coating to 2"

<b>TIMING</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ Snow enters from west to east Friday evening, 7pm to 10pm. Though areas along the east coast of Massachusetts onset of light snow between midnight and 2am.</li><li>▪ Moderate to heavy snow winds down early Saturday morning by 4am, with light snow showers lingering between 4am and 7am.</li></ul>
<b>HAZARDS &amp; IMPACTS</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ Snow accumulation on roadways could lead to slow and slick travel Friday night through Saturday morning.</li></ul>
<b>NWS ALERTS</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ Winter Weather Advisory expanded into western MA, all of CT, and southern RI.</li></ul>
<b>FORECAST CHALLENGES</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ Where the heaviest snow band sets up in SW CT.</li><li>▪ Ocean enhanced snow showers may boost snow totals in SE MA</li></ul>
<b>POST-EVENT OUTLOOK</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ Drier weather for Saturday afternoon and into early Sunday with below normal temperatures.</li><li>▪ Freezing rain chances increasing for late Sunday into early Monday</li></ul>
