

Freezing Rain Sunday Night - Monday



WEATHER FORECAST OFFICE

OVERVIEW:

- Low pressure passing west of Southern New England will bring a period of freezing rain Sunday night into the early part of Monday.
- A light glaze of ice for locations along I-95, but more significant icing is possible (up to a quarter-inch) in interior Southern New England where colder surface air will take longer to warm.

TIMING	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Developing Sunday evening from west to east, changing to rain by early Monday morning.
HAZARDS & IMPACTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Difficult travel, especially overnight to Monday morning commute, due to icy roads and sidewalks. Downed trees, powerlines & icy roads/sidewalks in upper CT & Merrimack Valleys where more significant icing is possible.
NWS ALERTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Winter Weather Advisory for areas along and northwest of I-95 Sunday night to Monday.
FORECAST CHALLENGES	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Sub-freezing air could be slower to warm in interior Southern New England, leading to an uncertain changeover timing to rain.
POST-EVENT OUTLOOK	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Rain with temps in the 40s Monday. Strong winds and frigid temperatures Monday night to Tuesday.
