OVERVIEW:

- High Wind Watch tonight into Tue night across western/central MA.
- Strong-damaging westerly wind gusts of 50 to 60 mph possible tonight into Tue night. Strongest of those winds expected Tue.
- Wind Chills dropping into the single digits & teens.

TIMING	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Strong westerly wind gusts develop tonight and continue into Tuesday night. Strongest of the winds gusts expected Tuesday.
HAZARDS & IMPACTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Downed branches, power lines and weakened trees.▪ Power outages are possible.
NWS ALERTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ High Wind Watch in effect for western & central MA.▪ Additional Wind Headlines will likely be needed for much of southern New England.
FORECAST CHALLENGES	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Long duration of the potential strong wind gusts. Also, some uncertainty in regards to the exact magnitude of the winds.
POST-EVENT OUTLOOK	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Dry, but chilly on Wed with westerly wind gusts of 20-30 mph and highs in the upper 20s to the middle 30s
