- Could end as a period of freezing rain after 8 PM for some.

HAZARDS & IMPACTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Untreated roads may become icy. ▪ The Monday evening commute will be impacted. ▪ Light glaze of ice with any snow accumulations 2" or less, locally up to 3: towards the Berkshires..
NWS ALERTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ None at this time. Winter Weather Advisories may be issued with later forecasts.
FORECAST CHALLENGES	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Overall risk for freezing rain and locations to be impacted ▪ When does it begin
