

Freezing Rain Tonight into Sun AM

OVERVIEW:

- Freezing rain is possible late this afternoon through Sunday morning across the higher elevations of the Berkshires and northern Worcester Hills.
- Ice accumulation between 0.1" and 0.2" across the Berkshires, while less ice, less than 0.1" is expected for the northern Worcester Hills.

TIMING	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Freezing rain begins between 5 PM and 8 PM, a few wet snowflakes are possible at the onset, but primary precipitation type is freezing rain.▪ Freezing rain ending between 8 AM and 10 AM.
HAZARDS & IMPACTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Untreated surfaces will become icy and cause slick travel.
NWS ALERTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Winter Weather Advisory for north central and western Massachusetts.
FORECAST CHALLENGES	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Confidence is moderate that the event will occur, though confidence is slightly lower in how widespread freezing rain will be.
POST-EVENT OUTLOOK	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Mainly dry Sunday with a low chance for a brief snow shower or snow squall late afternoon. Strong WNW winds Sunday night into Monday morning with gusts up to 40–50 mph.
