



OVERVIEW:

- Accumulating snow for western/central MA into northern CT.
- Snow accumulations of 1-2" in the lower elevations with 2-4" in the higher elevations of the Berks and northern Worcester Hills.
- No impacts expected for eastern MA and RI.

TIMING	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Snow overspreads interior MA & CT between 1 and 5 AM Sat. ▪ There may be a lull in the snow by mid-late morning with a second round in the afternoon. The snow should end by early Sat evening. ▪ No travel issues expected across eastern MA & RI.
HAZARDS & IMPACTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Untreated roads will be snow covered & slippery by daybreak Sat across interior MA & CT. ▪ Temps rise above freezing in lower elevations by Sat afternoon allowing for improvement. Higher elevations will remain near freezing.
NWS ALERTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ None at this time. Winter Weather Advisories may be issued for portions of western & central MA with the focus across the Berks and northern Worcester Hills.
FORECAST CHALLENGES	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ How quickly temps rise above freezing in the lower elevations of interior southern New England. ▪ High confidence in no issues in the BOS-PVD corridor.
POST-EVENT OUTLOOK	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Plowable snow possible Sun-Sun night but westward extent is uncertain. Greatest risk eastern MA/RI.
