



OVERVIEW:

- Areas of light snow develop Sunday morning into the afternoon.
- Steadiest and most impactful snow arrives late Sunday afternoon and evening especially across portions of southeastern MA & RI. Snow ending after midnight.
- Expected snow accumulations of 3-5” with localized amounts of 6” across southeast MA & RI. 2-4” of snow across northern CT through central and northeast MA.
 - Less amounts, 1-2” for northwest MA.

TIMING	▪ Light snow overspreads the region during the day Sunday. Steadiest snow and most impactful to travel occurs late Sunday afternoon and evening, especially across parts of southeastern MA and RI.	
HAZARDS & IMPACTS	▪ Untreated roads will become snow covered and slippery especially late Sunday afternoon and especially Sunday night.	
NWS ALERTS	▪ Winter Weather Advisory for CT, RI, and eastern MA from Sunday morning through Sunday night.	
FORECAST CHALLENGES	▪ Northwest extent of snow accumulations. ▪ Temperatures above freezing for the Islands may limit accumulations especially for Nantucket and Block Island.
