

Sun/Sun Night: Snow Potential

OVERVIEW:

- Areas of light snow develop Sun morning into the afternoon.
- Steadiest snow arrives late Sun afternoon and evening especially across portions of eastern MA & RI. Snow ends after midnight.
- Preliminary snow accumulations Sun into Sun night of 1-2" across the interior with 2-4" across parts of RI/SE MA.

TIMING	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Light snow overspreads the region during the day Sunday. Steadiest snow and biggest impact to travel will occur late Sunday afternoon and evening especially across parts of eastern MA and RI.
HAZARDS & IMPACTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Untreated roads will become snow covered and slippery especially late Sunday afternoon and especially Sunday night.
NWS ALERTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Another set of Winter Weather Advisories may need to be issued for portions of RI and eastern MA.
FORECAST CHALLENGES	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Duration and northwest extent of steady snow.▪ Northwest shift would result in 2-4" of snow across the interior with 3-6" in RI/SE MA. A shift southeast would just be a dusting to 2".
POST-EVENT OUTLOOK	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Partly sunny and breezy on Monday with highs in the upper 20s to the middle 30s.
