



OVERVIEW:

- Light snow resumes this afternoon between 2 - 6pm.
- Bulk of the accumulating snow & most difficult travel conditions occur between 6pm and 2am.
- Additional snow accumulations of 3 - 5” with highest amounts in eastern MA where localized 6” amounts are possible.

TIMING	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ .Heaviest snow/worst travel conditions between 6 pm and 2 am▪ Steady snow will end from west to east from 3am and 9am	
HAZARDS & IMPACTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Untreated roads will become snow covered and slippery especially this evening and tonight.Accumulation rates over ½” per hour expected between 6 pm and 2 am, especially across eastern MA & RI.	
NWS ALERTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Winter Weather Advisory for all of SNE except Nantucket & Block Island.	
FORECAST CHALLENGES	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ How much rain cuts down the accumulations across the Cape/Islands.▪ How far northwest do the ½” per hour snowfall rates extend▪ Extent of lingering snow showers into the Monday AM commute.
