- Wind chill temperatures between -10 and -20 degrees are likely across southern New England Friday night into Saturday morning
- Increasing potential for an impactful Snow Storm Sunday-Monday

<b>TIMING</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Peak of cold temperatures will be late Friday night into early Saturday AM</li> <li>▪ Potential for snow is highest Sunday into Sunday night</li> </ul>	
<b>HAZARDS &amp; IMPACTS</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Dangerously cold wind chill temperatures between -10 and -20 degrees</li> <li>▪ Increasing potential for moderate impacts from accumulating snow</li> </ul>	
<b>NWS ALERTS</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ None at this time</li> </ul>	
<b>FORECAST CHALLENGES</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Cold: Uncertainty with respect to how low temperatures will fall</li> <li>▪ Snow: Uncertainty remains in storm track and potential snowfall amounts</li> </ul>
