

Dangerous Cold Tonight into Friday Night

OVERVIEW:

- Arctic air moving in will produce dangerous wind chill temperatures between 20 and 25 below zero tonight into Friday morning.
- Dangerous wind chills could continue into Friday night and Saturday morning.

TIMING	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Lowest wind chills by sunrise Friday morning, then slowly recovering into Friday late morning.
HAZARDS & IMPACTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Increased risk for frostbite and hypothermia with prolonged exposure to dangerous cold wind chills.
NWS ALERTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Cold Weather Advisory for most of Southern New England except for the Cape and Islands 7 PM tonight through 11 AM Friday.
FORECAST CHALLENGES	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Lower wind speeds makes it more uncertain if lower elevations see dangerous wind chills Friday night into Saturday morning, although it will still be very cold.
POST-EVENT OUTLOOK	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Well below normal temperatures continue into Saturday, but with less wind.▪ Monitoring possible coastal storm Sunday.
NEXT BRIEFING	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ By 3 PM Thursday.
