




OVERVIEW:

- Arctic air moving in will produce dangerous wind chill temperatures between 20 and 25 below zero tonight into Friday morning.
- Dangerous wind chills could continue into Friday night and Saturday morning.

TIMING	▪ Lowest wind chills by sunrise Friday morning, then slowly recovering into Friday late morning.	
HAZARDS & IMPACTS	▪ Increased risk for frostbite and hypothermia with prolonged exposure to dangerous cold wind chills.	
NWS ALERTS	▪ Cold Weather Advisory for most of Southern New England except for the Cape and Islands 7 PM tonight through 11 AM Friday.	
FORECAST CHALLENGES	▪ Lower wind speeds makes it more uncertain if lower elevations see dangerous wind chills Friday night into Saturday morning, although it will still be very cold.
