OVERVIEW:

- Dangerous wind chill temperatures between 15 and 30 below zero Saturday night into Sunday morning.
- Strong wind gusts 35 to 45 mph late Saturday into Saturday night.
- Light snow accumulations late Friday night into Saturday evening.

TIMING	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Lowest wind chills after midnight Sat night into Sunday morning.▪ Strongest wind gusts late Saturday into Saturday night.
HAZARDS & IMPACTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Increased risk for frostbite and hypothermia with prolonged exposure to dangerous cold wind chills.
NWS ALERTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Extreme Cold Watch for the Berkshires 6 PM Saturday through Noon Sunday.
FORECAST CHALLENGES	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Cold weather headlines will likely be needed for the rest of southern New England.▪ How strong wind gusts will be late Sat and Sat night.
POST-EVENT OUTLOOK	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Very cold and blustery through the day on Sunday.▪ Less wind Sunday night but temperatures falling below zero in many locations away from the coast..
