OVERVIEW:

- Dangerous wind chill temperatures between 15 and 30 below zero Saturday night into Sunday morning.
- Strong wind gusts 30 to 40 mph late Saturday into Saturday night.
- Minor snow accumulations late Friday night into Saturday evening.

TIMING	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Lowest wind chills after midnight Sat night into Sunday morning.▪ Strongest wind gusts late Saturday into Saturday night.▪ Snowfall late Friday night through Saturday.	
HAZARDS & IMPACTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Increased risk for frostbite and hypothermia with prolonged exposure to dangerous cold wind chills.▪ Snow covered roadways.	
NWS ALERTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Extreme Cold Watch for the western and central Massachusetts and northern Connecticut 6 PM Saturday through 1 PM Sunday.	
FORECAST CHALLENGES	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ How widespread the strongest wind gusts and duration. Areas not covered by Extreme Cold headlines will likely need Cold Weather Advisories.▪ Axis of highest snow totals.	
POST-EVENT OUTLOOK	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Very cold and blustery through the day on Sunday.▪ Less wind Sunday night but temperatures falling below zero in many locations away from the coast..
