

# Dangerous Cold Sat Night into Sunday

## OVERVIEW:

- Dangerous wind chill temperatures between 15 and 30 below zero Saturday night into Sunday morning.
- Strong wind gusts 30 to 40 mph late Saturday into Saturday night.
- Minor snow accumulations late Friday night into Saturday evening.

<b>TIMING</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ Lowest wind chills after midnight Sat night into Sunday morning.</li><li>▪ Strongest wind gusts late Saturday into Saturday night.</li><li>▪ Snowfall late Friday night through Saturday.</li></ul>
<b>HAZARDS &amp; IMPACTS</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ Increased risk for frostbite and hypothermia with prolonged exposure to dangerous cold wind chills.</li><li>▪ Snow covered roadways.</li></ul>
<b>NWS ALERTS</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ Extreme Cold Watch for the western and central Massachusetts and northern Connecticut 6 PM Saturday through 1 PM Sunday.</li></ul>
<b>FORECAST CHALLENGES</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ How widespread the strongest wind gusts and duration. Areas not covered by Extreme Cold headlines will likely need Cold Weather Advisories.</li><li>▪ Axis of highest snow totals.</li></ul>
<b>POST-EVENT OUTLOOK</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ Very cold and blustery through the day on Sunday.</li><li>▪ Less wind Sunday night but temperatures falling below zero in many locations away from the coast..</li></ul>
<b>NEXT BRIEFING</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ By 6 AM Friday.</li></ul>
