OVERVIEW:

- Dangerous wind chill temperatures between 15 and 30 below zero Saturday night into Sunday morning.
- 1-4 inches of snow accumulation later Friday night into Saturday evening, with locally higher amounts possible in eastern MA



| TIMING | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Lowest wind chills after midnight Sat night into Sunday morning. ▪ Snow begins later Fri night but heaviest snowfall during Saturday. Snowfall rates up to 1"/hr possible in the afternoon in eastern MA. |
| HAZARDS & IMPACTS | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Increased risk for frostbite and hypothermia with prolonged exposure to dangerous cold wind chills. ▪ Hazardous travel conditions due to snow covered roads. |
| NWS ALERTS | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Extreme Cold Warning for western and central MA and northern CT ▪ Cold Weather Advisories for rest of southern New England except Nantucket |
| FORECAST CHALLENGES | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Where heavier snow bands set up ▪ Potential for localized snowfall up to 6 inches in heaviest bands. ▪ Winter Weather Advisories will likely be issued this afternoon for portions of southern New England |
| POST-EVENT OUTLOOK | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Very cold and blustery through the day on Sunday. ▪ Less wind Sunday night but temperatures falling below zero in many locations away from the coast.. |
