OVERVIEW:

- A weak clipper system brings another round of snow to the area late Tuesday afternoon and evening
- Snowfall totals of 1-3 inches across northern Massachusetts, with isolated 4+ inch amounts possible in northeast Massachusetts. A coating to 2 inches likely across CT/RI and southeast MA.

TIMING	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Light snow/flurries develop late Tue afternoon, with steadiest and accumulating snow Tuesday evening from roughly 7 PM to Midnight.
HAZARDS & IMPACTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Roads will become snow covered and slippery Tuesday evening & overnight. Snow may end as a period of freezing drizzle Tue night.
NWS ALERTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ None at the moment.
FORECAST CHALLENGES	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Areal coverage of 3-4" and isolated 4+ amounts across northern MA.

POST-EVENT OUTLOOK	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Dry weather returns Wednesday. Not as cold, but temperatures only rising slightly above freezing for a few hours Wednesday afternoon
