

Snowfall Late Tue Afternoon/Evening

WEATHER FORECAST OFFICE

OVERVIEW:

- Weak clipper system will bring a round of snow to the region late this afternoon into this evening, with a changeover to rain along the south coast.
- Snowfall totals of 1–3 inches across northern MA, with isolated amounts up to 4 inches possible in northeast MA. A coating to 2 inches is expected across CT, RI, and southeast MA.
- Localized freezing drizzle are possible, mainly across southwestern MA and portions of CT, which could lead to isolated slick spots.

TIMING	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Light snow develops late Tuesday afternoon, with the main period of accumulating snow Tuesday evening (approximately 7 PM–12 AM).
HAZARDS & IMPACTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Snow-covered and slippery road conditions are expected Tuesday evening through the overnight hours. As snow ends, a brief period of freezing drizzle is possible late Tuesday night, which could worsen travel conditions.
NWS ALERTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Winter Weather Advisories are in effect for 2–4 inches of snow in northeast Massachusetts and a light glaze of ice in parts of central Connecticut and southwest Massachusetts.
FORECAST CHALLENGES	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ How widespread 3-4" of snow will accumulate in northeastern Massachusetts and extent of mixed precipitation types across the south coast, and how widespread freezing drizzle becomes.
POST-EVENT OUTLOOK	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Dry weather returns Wednesday. Not as cold, but temperatures only rising slightly above freezing for a few hours Wednesday afternoon.
