- Expecting a period of snow, rain, and freezing rain Friday through Saturday afternoon.
- Greatest risk for several inches of snow across northern MA.
- Light ice accretion possible, mainly across interior MA NW of I-495.

| POST-EVENT OUTLOOK | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Another winter storm may impact southern New England Sunday evening into Monday, but confidence in significant impacts remains low at this time. |
