




## OVERVIEW:

- Light snowfall develops after midnight Wednesday and continues into Wednesday morning.
- Transition to rain expected across the lower elevations into the afternoon.

<b>TIMING</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ After midnight Wednesday into late Wednesday afternoon</li> </ul>
<b>HAZARDS &amp; IMPACTS</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Slippery untreated surfaces</li> </ul>
<b>NWS ALERTS</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ None at this time</li> </ul>
<b>FORECAST CHALLENGES</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Timing the arrival of the snowfall</li> <li>▪ How quickly temperatures rise above freezing Wednesday</li> </ul>
<b>POST-EVENT OUTLOOK</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Another coastal low pressure may approach southern New England sometime late Thursday into Friday.</li> <li>▪ Daytime temperatures above freezing should lead to orderly melting of existing snowpack.</li> </ul>
