



## OVERVIEW:

- Snow develops Tuesday afternoon in the interior and changes to rain and freezing rain late Tuesday and Tuesday night.
- A coating to an inch of snow is possible along with a trace to one tenth of an inch of ice accretion, especially over higher elevations.

<b>TIMING</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Snow begins 12-3 pm from west to east</li> <li>▪ Snow changing to rain and freezing rain and between 6-10 pm from south to north</li> <li>▪ Precipitation ending late Tuesday night.</li> </ul>
<b>HAZARDS &amp; IMPACTS</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Untreated roads may become slippery.</li> <li>▪ The Tuesday evening commute may be impacted, especially over the higher elevations.</li> </ul>
<b>NWS ALERTS</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Winter Weather Advisories for areas north and west of I-95 (includes N CT, NW RI and interior and NE MA).</li> </ul>
<b>FORECAST CHALLENGES</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Temperatures when precip arrives.</li> <li>▪ How much will roads be impacted in the afternoon? The greater impact may be delayed until Tuesday night</li> </ul>
<b>POST-EVENT OUTLOOK</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Dry and mild Wed. More wintry mixed precip Thu night into Friday.</li> </ul>
<b>NEXT BRIEFING</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ 6 AM Tue.</li> </ul>


