

# Heavy Rain/River Flooding Possible Early Next Week

## OVERVIEW

- Heavy rain Monday night/Tuesday may result in minor to moderate river flooding
- Increased risk for ice jam river flooding as mild air and increasing streamflow continues to support ice breakup in rivers


### TIMING

- Heavy Rain Monday and Monday Night
- Rivers likely cresting between Tuesday and Friday of next week depending on location

### HAZARDS & IMPACTS

- 1-2" of rain with localized 3+" possible may result in minor to moderate river flooding along area rivers in southern New England
- Potential for strong to damaging southerly wind gusts

## Southern New England River Forecast Points



### FORECAST CHALLENGES

- How high will rivers rise in response to heavy rainfall?
- Which watersheds receive the most rainfall will govern which rivers rise to flood stage

### POST-EVENT OUTLOOK

- No signal at this time for additional precipitation events that would exacerbate any potential flooding
