



OVERVIEW:

- Strong to damaging southerly winds gusts of 45 to 65 mph tonight. Strongest winds eastern MA/RI - localized gust to 70 mph possible.
- Periods of heavy rain & embedded t-storms will result in some flooding of rivers, small streams, & urban/poor drainage areas.

TIMING	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Strong to damaging southerly wind gusts peak tonight (10 pm to 4 am). ▪ Periods of heavy rain & embedded t-storms today and tonight. ▪ Rivers likely cresting between Tue-Fri depending on location.
HAZARDS & IMPACTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Tree damage and power outages from damaging wind gusts ▪ 1-3" of rain with localized higher amounts may result in minor to moderate river flooding along area rivers in southern New England. Urban and poor drainage street flooding also possible.
NWS Alerts	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ High Wind Warning eastern MA & RI. Wind Advisory elsewhere. ▪ Flood Watch all areas except the outer-Islands. ▪ Storm Warnings all Waters.
FORECAST CHALLENGES	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Are strongest wind gusts 40 to 55 mph or do they reach 55-70 mph. ▪ How high will rivers rise in response to heavy rainfall?
POSTEVENT OUTLOOK	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ No signal at this time for additional precipitation events that would exacerbate any potential flooding.
