OVERVIEW:

- A period of freezing rain is expected Today across much of southern New England north and west of the I-95 corridor

TIMING	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Beginning after 7 am today and ending between 4-6 pm this evening.
HAZARDS & IMPACTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Areas that see freezing rain will likely see ice accumulate on untreated roads creating dangerous travel conditions.
NWS ALERTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Winter Weather Advisory in effect 7am-7pm Sunday for Worcester, Franklin, Hampshire, Hampden, and Berkshire counties in MA and Tolland, Hartford, Litchfield, Fairfield, and New Haven counties in CT. Winter weather advisory for Windham, central Middlesex, western Essex, and northwest Providence counties from 7am - 10am.
FORECAST CHALLENGES	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> How far east will the freezing rain threat extend? Exact timing for the changeover from freezing rain to all rain? How much if any impact does gusty south winds have on ice accumulation?
POST-EVENT OUTLOOK	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Colder Monday Arctic blast Tue with potentially dangerously cold wind chill temperatures. Mariners - likely moderate to heavy freezing spray Tue
