



## OVERVIEW:

- Rapidly strengthening low pressure will bring a brief period of heavy rain to Rhode Island and eastern Massachusetts
- Strong winds, up to 50 mph, expected across eastern Essex County, Cape Cod and the Islands

<b>TIMING</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Rain begins after 8 PM with heaviest rain between 2 AM and 6 AM Mon</li> <li>▪ Strongest winds to occur between 1 AM and 7 AM Mon</li> </ul>
<b>HAZARDS &amp; IMPACTS</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Sporadic instances of minor flooding in urban and poor drainage areas</li> <li>▪ Sporadic tree or powerline damage across the North Shore, Cape Cod and the Islands.</li> <li>▪ Minor splashover is possible in Narragansett Bay around the AM high tide</li> </ul>
<b>NWS ALERTS</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ A Wind Advisory is in place for Eastern Essex County &amp; Cape Cod and the Islands between 1-7AM Monday</li> <li>▪ A Coastal Flood Statement is in effect for Narragansett Bay surrounding the AM high tide</li> <li>▪ Gale Warnings are in place for most of the waters</li> </ul>
<b>FORECAST CHALLENGES</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Impacts from peak wind gusts may be more isolated if any occur.</li> <li>▪ If stronger winds coincide with high tide, coastal flooding impacts may increase along the South Coast but not likely any worse than minor flooding.</li> </ul>
<b>POST-EVENT OUTLOOK</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Improvement after 7AM Monday</li> <li>▪ Blustery and cold Tue and Wed.</li> </ul>
