## OVERVIEW:

- Line of showers and t-storms expected to move into SNE from the west Sat evening.
- Potential for some storms to be strong to severe.
- Damaging wind gusts are the primary risk.

<b>TIMING</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ 5 pm to 11 pm Saturday</li> </ul>
<b>HAZARDS &amp; IMPACTS</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Localized strong to damaging wind gusts which could cause isolated tree damage</li> <li>▪ Hail is a secondary risk and there is also a low risk for an isolated tornado</li> <li>▪ All SNE is at risk for severe t-storms but the highest risk is across interior MA and CT</li> </ul>
<b>NWS ALERTS</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ SPC has upgraded to a Slight Risk of Severe Weather across the interior.</li> </ul>
<b>FORECAST CHALLENGES</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ The amount of sunshine Saturday afternoon which will determine magnitude of instability</li> <li>▪ Will the threat of severe t-storms extend into eastern MA and RI? The greatest risk is across interior MA into CT.</li> </ul>
<b>POST-EVENT OUTLOOK</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Blustery and colder Sunday with highs in the mid/upper 40s.</li> <li>▪ NW winds 20-30 mph.</li> </ul>
